MONDAY (DAY)

A pair may not play together in both the Championship Pairs and Open Pairs.

A pair may play together in more than one 3 day pairs competition. They are only eligible to win the first competition in which they are entered.

Alice Paterson Salver — Championship Pairs

One substitute allowed on any session, or one session may be missed, or lowest score discarded.

Open Pairs

One substitute allowed on any session, or one session may be missed, or lowest score discarded.

Ladder —

Different partner each day.

One Day may be missed, or lowest score discarded.

McLaren Trophy —

Highest aggregate score of Championship, Open Pairs & Ladder. Best 13 days (13 days must be played.) Honours Board.

Joan Dreadon Plate —

This trophy will be awarded to the 1st or 2nd year player who scored most points in the Points Prize.

Joan Dreadon Trophy —

Points awarded N-S and E-W. 1st - 6; 2nd - 5, to 6th - 1.

Three Day Pairs

All days to be played.

One substitute allowed on any day.

Brenda Travers Trophy —

Winner of the Manukau Pairs.

BRIDGE ETIQUETTE

Members are requested to read and observe the following. It cannot be emphasized too strongly that good manners make the game of Bridge.

GENERAL

- ♠ Do not arrive late. Be seated 10 minutes prior to start of play.
- ♥ Give the person making the announcements your full attention.
- ♦ Do not be embarrassed to call the Director.
- ♣ Hold your cards up at all times.
- ♠ Remember, Bridge is a game played for the pleasure of four people, so do not embarrass your partner - or your opponents - by recriminations.

THE PLAY

Initial Hand

Players will toss a coin; the winner must sit North / South.

Only when the score sheet is entered should there be any discussion on the hand.

Moving

North / South should welcome the incoming pair.

Bidding

Your first action when you remove the cards from the board should be to count them. You can be penalised if you commence to play with the wrong number of cards.

Dummy

The dummy player is responsible for playing the cards from the hand laid out in front of him / her, on instructions from his / her partner, the player of the contract. On No Account should dummy touch cards without direction from declarer.

Scoring

East / West are responsible for checking that the score is credited to the correct side.

WEDNESDAY

A pair may not compete together in both the Championship Pairs and Mixed Pairs. A pair may play together in more than one 3 Night Pairs. But they are only eligible to win the first 3 Night Pairs in which they are entered. Also any points gained together after the first 3-night pairs, may not be included for the Wilson Cup.

Alan Somerville Memorial Trophy — Championship Pairs

One substitute allowed on any night, or one night may be missed, or lowest score discarded.

Championship Pairs Howes Plate — Runners up

Rules as for Championship Pairs.

Club Trophy — Mixed Pairs

A mixed pair or women's pair only eligible to win this trophy. Rules as for Championship Pairs.

Karaka Cup — Handicap Individual

This competition will run concurrently with 5 Ladder Nights. May miss 1 night, or lowest score discarded. Different Partner each night.

Handicap Pairs Plate — run concurrently with Championship Pairs — the Championship Pairs winners are not eligible to win this event.

Three Night Pairs

All nights to be played. One substitute allowed on any night.

Merv Kelly Memorial Trophy — Championship Ladder

The winner is not eligible to win the Handicap Individual, or the Bingham Trophy. May miss one night or lowest score discarded.

Bingham Trophy — Runner Up Championship Ladder

Runner Up in Ladder Competition — winner is not eligible to win Karaka Cup.

Gibson Plate

Highest aggregate score of Championship and Mixed Pairs and Ladder. Best 13 nights (13 nights must be played). Honours Boards.

Wilson Cup

Points prize.

Points awarded N-S & E-W. 1st - 6; 2nd - 5 to 6th - 1 point.

Alice Paterson Trophy

This trophy will be awarded to the 1st or 2nd year player who scores most points in the Wilson Cup.

Sumpter Cup

Awarded to the best Team of Four over the four nights.

Maplesden Rosebowl

Runners up in the Mixed Pairs. Rules as for the Mixed Pairs.

COMPETITION RULES
(All Nights and Day)

Substitutes—All substitutes must be Club members and recorded on travelling sheet. A substitute may be awarded C Points, Wilson Cup points, or Joan Dreadon Trophy points.

Individual Event—If the same partners play together in any ladder or individual event the first score only counts for the competition, the Gibson Plate or the McLaren Trophy.

All decisions and special dispensations to be made by the Match Committee.
